Workshops

In the new triennial period, many members are taking on new roles at diocesan level. While those who are elected as trustees, coordinators, etc will have a range of expertise and experience on which to draw, there may be aspects of the role where they may have less confidence and would appreciate the opportunity to refresh their skills.

The following training packages are available for any diocese on request for groups of 12 – 18 participants (apart from the PowerPoint training which is a maximum of six). Neighbouring dioceses may wish to arrange a joint session.

Chairing meetings (half day)

Setting agenda, working with committee members, making meetings productive

Delegation and working with others (half day)

Principles of delegation, identifying skills and abilities, making delegation work for you

Speaking from the front (full day)

Creating a presentation, engaging your audience, using visual aids

Team building (half or full day)

Developing and growing together, utilising skills, interdependency

An introduction to PowerPoint (full day)

Getting started, creating presentations, simple animation. As this is a 'hands on' there is a maximum of six participants for this session.
