You don't know me, but I know one thing about you, and I want to say 'thank you' for what you have done.

My name is Francine Nsabimana and I live with my husband Jerome and our six children in a village called Bibuye in the country of Burundi.

I am saddened to say that I used to have no peace in my heart or in my family.

I was really miserable, with no money for food or clothes and I didn't live in perfect harmony with my husband, because we didn't have the words to speak to each other. We lived in a straw house with a roof that let the rainwater in. I was always afraid that it would fall onto my children one day.

I didn't have clean clothes or soap to wash myself so I didn't want to go to church and I was afraid to approach others to find out how I could improve my life, as I knew no better.

One day I heard about this programme from my neighbours who told me that there is a literacy and numeracy circle opened by Mothers' Union in my parish. So I joined even though I felt ashamed of how I looked. I hoped that this programme would improve my living situation.

That is the thing I know about you <Salutation>, that you have supported Mothers' Union and so I have you to thank for making my life better. God bless you.

from our literacy and numeracy programme, "Terintambwe" is how to manage household activities and to save money for a farming business in order to get profits and carry out the family projects.

I also learned from the programme how to strengthen my relationship with God. I pray deeply and also I am able to pray for me, my children and others.

One thing I put into practice is that now I can be hygienic. I am able to wash clothes and be happy to meet others at church.

Another big change is that I can communicate well with my husband and my children. It is not like before when I isolated myself and didn't work with my husband. **Now, the communication with my husband has been improved and I'm so happy.** 

I can manage the soy harvest we produce and save it for the family. We took the decision together of buying tiles for our house which before was covered in straw. We now live in a beautiful house and can get food without any problem. My children are very happy.

### Again, thank you and God bless you for your kindness.

I started seeing changes to my life in three months. The biggest change to my life experience is that I was able to buy a goat. I bought it as a kid but now it has grown, multiplied and produced three other goats.

This programme has made me very glad. I feel a great joy because you have helped me make a remarkable change to my life and also my husband Jerome and our children.

It will soon be that time of year when we celebrate the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ. I would like to ask you something. **Would you make a Christmas gift today to help other parishes start their own literacy and numeracy circles?** 

I see many people in our village who were like I once was. I encourage them to join as soon as possible after hearing about it because it will remove them from ignorance and open their minds.

Once again, thank you for supporting Mothers' Union. Your support of this programme has brought light into my life and I would love you to support it with a gift this Christmas, to bring light into the lives of others like me in Burundi.
