

'May the peoples praise you, God; may all the peoples praise you. The land yields its harvest; God, our God, blesses us.

I would like to talk to you about the plight of people all around the world facing challenges at Harvest. We have developed innovative, proven projects that work but we need your help reaching more people.

Seventeen million Kenyans live on below £1.50 a day and Maize is a staple food for 80 per cent of the Kenyan population. When crops fail it can devastate a community, for the last eight years the maize crop has failed.

Changes in weather patterns have brought droughts on significant scales. Droughts provided conditions for blights like Maize Lethal Necrosis Disease. When the rains come, so does the Fall Armyworm – which will devastate acres of farmland.

Planting seasons were once fixed and ran like clockwork. Now they can shift by months. Land must be left fallow for four months where diseased crops are identified. But you still need to feed your family and earn an in-

come.

For £39.50 we could provide essential food supplies to communities hit by crop devastation. This vital lifeline means families do not face destruction and allows a vital foundation block for communities to grow stronger and more resilient.

Communities are left hungry and unable to feed themselves or their families. That is why Eggs are now laying the foundation for a Kenyan family's future. All because their mother (and grandmother) Cherise* has started a small poultry business. She sells eggs when her crops fail. Despite drought and disease, income is flowing for Cherise. The secret of her success? A saving and credit programme developed by Mothers' Union Kenya that has given her the hope she needed to be in control of her own life.

Members pay small regular amounts and the money saved provides small loans, which could allow a small local business to be started, a variety of crops seed to be bought or simply allowing the money to grow with interest.

Coupled with literacy and numeracy education, this gives women financial security. It means by end of year they're more secure, their communities are stronger and their families aren't relying on one wage to survive.

£39.50 could help us establish more of these groups with expertise and training. Please help mothers like Cherise.

The savings and credit group have also been able to give back to their community. They've set up a small market linked to Cherise

church where people can sell produce or goods. It has helped her break the cycle of poverty and adapt to the challenges of changing climate.

'We need to adapt, to prepare for seasons of drought,' said Cherise, 'but also to look for ways to earn incomes in different ways. We have to change to survive.'

The savings and credit group means they can buy better seeds, livestock and grow cash crops. 'Alone we couldn't do this,' said Cherise, 'but together we can.'

There are more communities – **not only in Kenya but also around the world** – that are affected by the impacts of changing weather, droughts and floods. We need to empower them to find immediate change – and support them to plan for the future.

It's right to give thanks for the food on our table, the family we share it with and the love we have for God. But we're all too aware that communities across the globe struggle to feed themselves and their families.
