## Make a pompom!

## Take some time to pray for someone in your community, who you think needs some support.

## Be creative and make a pompom while you reflect.

- 1. Decide on what size pom pom you would like.
- 2. Cut out 2 identical rings and place together back to back.
- 3. Tie the end of your wool so that it goes through the middle of the ring, and then repeatedly loop the wool through the hole so that you eventually will have a layer of wool around the ring.
- 4. Continue to loop until the hole is much smaller. The smaller the hole, the fuller the pom pom will be.
- 5. Take a pair of scissors and cut the wool along the edge of the ring so that the scissors are placed in between the two cardboard rings. Cut all the wool so that they are only held together by the ring.
- 6. Using a new length of wool, wrap t he string around the pom pom at the bottom near the cardboard rings, tie it very tight with a knot so that the pom pom is secured.
- 7. Remove the cardboard and trim the pom pom if needed to make neat.

## Here are some ways you can use your pom pom:

- 1. Use yellow wool to make your pom pom look like the sun and then give it to someone who may need a bit of sunshine in their lives.
- 2. Hang your pompom in your window to brighten up your street.
- 3. Attach your pom pom to some twigs and pop them in a vase to brighten up your home.
- 4. Make them together as a branch and give them as a gift, a pom pom bouquet, to share God's grace with someone you know.
