God's calling to Caritas in Burundi

Caritas remembers, "I first joined the Mothers' Union Literacy programme as a learner. When I became literate, I decided to volunteer to become a facilitator myself, inspired by the love and care I saw in our facilitator and trainers."

Caritas received training to teach literacy, form savings groups, business skills and parenting, and used her training to support others. "I started with a group of 25 illiterate people, and continued to form new groups," she says. "The 175 people I support today are now involved in savings groups, parenting and fighting sexual and gender-based violence."



Supporting women and families in the UK

Here in Britain, Karen Morris took her first steps on her leadership journey when she was adjusting to life as a new mum. She remembers, "It was when I was first introduced to MU's Passionate about Parenting Programme that I felt God's calling. It was as if a seed was being planted deep within my heart."

Karen went on to train as a Parents Group Facilitator and says that, "Having supported many parents, I have observed transformational things happen, relationships restored and family life flourishing. My prayer is that more women will be called to serve in this way and that their lives will also be transformed in Christ." Karen is now a Diocesan President, and supports even more women through other leadership roles she has taken on in her community.

This Jubilee Summer of Hope, I pray that you too can feel God's calling and the blessing of our worldwide community as you support one other.

I am enclosing with my letter, an Activities Booklet filled with ideas, prayers and ways you can celebrate the Queen's Jubilee.
