Welcome to Durban

Durban, also known as the Miami of South Africa, is a vibrant coastal city known for its rich cultural heritage, stunning beaches, and as the busiest port in Africa.

Durban is in the province of KwaZuluNatal, the third largest city in South Africa after Johannesburg and Cape Town. It lies along the eastern coast on the Indian Ocean, specifically on Natal Bay. The city experiences a humid subtropical climate with hot, wet summers and mild, dry winters. As of 2022, the Durban metropolitan area had an estimated population of 4.2 million, making it one of the largest urban regions in Africa.

The area now known as Durban has a long and rich history, beginning with its early inhabitants, including the Nguni people. The city was officially founded in 1835 and named after Sir Benjamin D'Urban, then governor of the Cape Colony. European settlement began earlier, in 1824, when English traders established a trading post at Port Natal. Over time, Durban evolved from a small trading settlement into a thriving metropolis shaped by diverse cultural influences, most notably from the Zulu and Indian communities.



Durban is home to Africa's busiest port, one of the largest and most important ports in the world. This port serves as a major gateway for trade, supporting the export of minerals, coal, sugar, and grain. The city is also a critical hub for manufacturing and tourism, drawing millions of visitors each year with its beaches, cultural attractions, and major sporting venues. Among these is the iconic Moses Mabhida Stadium, which hosted matches during the 2010 FIFA World Cup and remains a significant landmark in the city.



Durban is a major tourism destination thanks to its coastal setting, subtropical climate, and range of natural attractions. The city is famed for the Golden Mile, a stretch of beachfront lined with hotels, restaurants, promenades, and surf spots. Nearby ecological treasures include the Valley of a Thousand Hills, uMngeni River estuary, and numerous nature reserves that showcase KwaZulu-Natal's biodiversity. The city is also a gateway to the Drakensberg Mountains and the iSimangaliso Wetland Park, both UNESCO World Heritage Sites. These attractions support a robust tourism industry, which plays a key role in the city's economy.



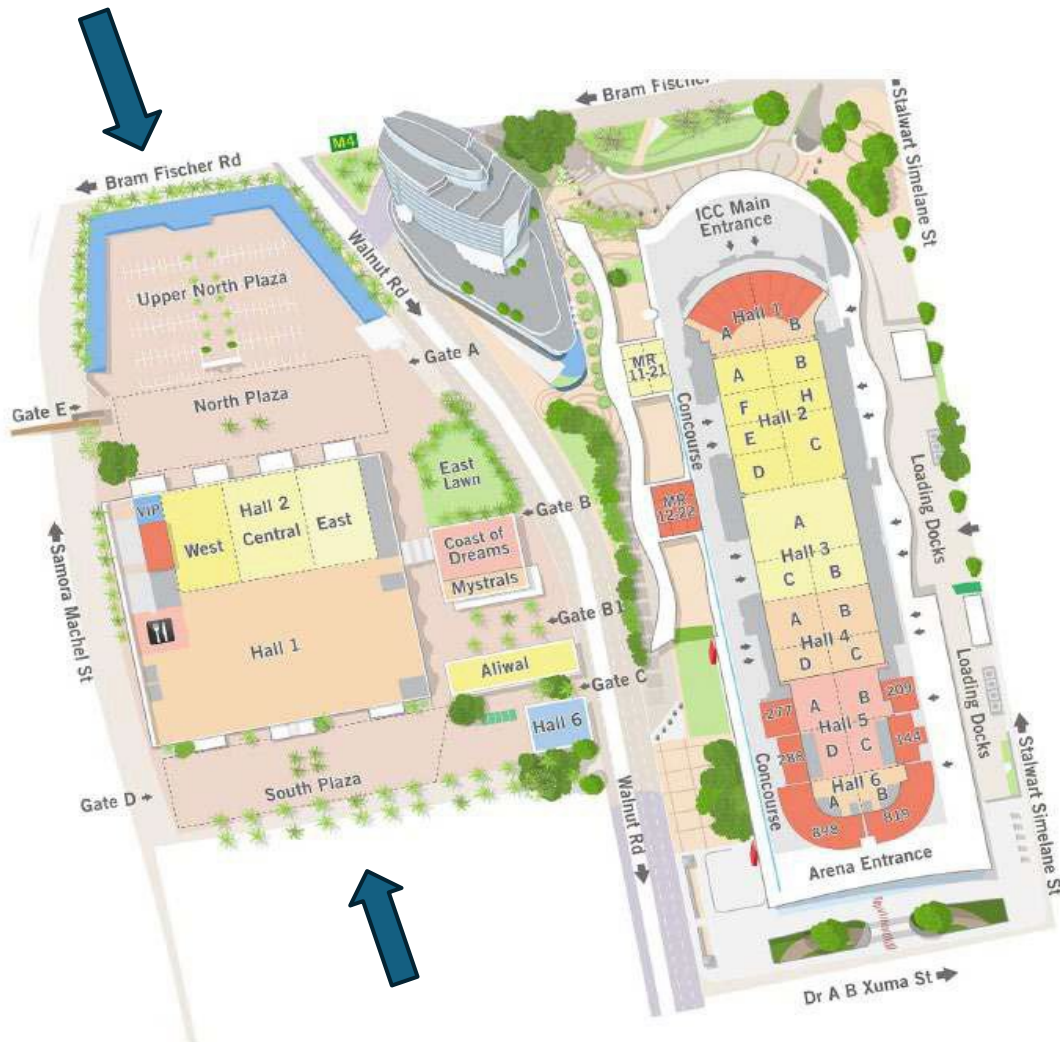
Venue for the event

Location: ICC Durban, South Africa (Exhibition Centre)

We are delighted that the Worldwide Gathering will be taking place at The Durban Exhibition Centre, which is part of the ICC and located adjacent to it. This space has been chosen for its flexibility, so we can worship alongside the conference aspects of the event. The ICC Durban itself is in a great location, just 35 minutes from King Shaka International Airport and within walking / quick car journey distance of many of Durban's premier hotels and its iconic beachfront. It is recognised as Africa's Leading Conference Centre; the ICC has hosted numerous major international events, including the United Nations Climate Change Convention, and we are thrilled that we will be holding our first-ever international event of this scale at this venue.

Tickets

We are currently working with an external platform, handling all the ticket sales from across the globe in the most efficient way possible, and the registration desks for the event. There will also be an app available for the duration of the event, this will also provide us with an app for the duration of the event, which you will be able to download before the event and access lots of exciting information.

- **Lunch will not be included on 30 September or 3 October. You are welcome to bring snacks with you to the conference centre and there will also be vendors to purchase additional food, coffee and drinks from – all at an additional cost.**
- **There are no cash machines on site so you will need to bring cash or contactless payment with you.**
- **All tickets must be purchased before the event – you will not be able to attend the event without a valid ticket, and there will be NO admissions on the door.**

Lunch & refreshments

On day 2 & 3 (1–2 October) there will be a lunch break during the Conference from **12:30 – 2:00pm**. Travelling to Durban

Major Airports

King Shaka International Airport (DUR) is Durban's primary international gateway.

- Located approximately 35 km north of Durban city centre
- Opened in 2010 and handles both international and domestic flights, serving the region's major routes ("Golden Triangle": Durban–Johannesburg–Cape Town).

Transport Options from the Airport to Hotels

Delegates are responsible for arranging and covering all airport transfers.

Available transport options include:

- Taxi or e-hailing (Uber/Bolt)
 - Widely used and considered the most convenient for visitors.
 - Typical travel time to central Durban: 35–70 minutes depending on traffic.
- Airport Shuttle Buses
 - Shuttle vans ("Air Bus") and similar services operate from the airport to major hotels and Durban Beachfront.
 - Some services run every 45 minutes from the airport's Public Transport Parking area.
- Private Transfers
 - Pre-bookable shuttle and private driver services are available for seamless hotel drop-of. If preferred, please arrange directly in advance.
- Car Rental
 - Major global and local rental companies operate directly at the airport terminal.
- **You may want to contact your chosen hotel, as most hotels offer complimentary or paid airport shuttle transfers.**

Arriving by Sea – Durban Port

For guests arriving via cruise or marine transport:

- Durban's main passenger facility is N-Shed Cruise Terminal, located a short distance (approx. 5–10 minutes) from the city centre.
- A range of private taxis, shuttles, and pre-booked transfer services operate from the port to city hotels and airport destinations.
- Cruise travellers are advised to avoid unlicensed taxis and use recognised shuttle/taxi services only.



All port-to-hotel transfers remain the responsibility of the delegates.

Arriving by Road

Durban is well connected by major national highways, including:

- **N3** – linking Durban to Johannesburg (approx. 6 hrs by road).
- **N2** – serving the North and South Coast and connecting KwaZulu-Natal's major towns.

Delegates arriving by road are responsible for planning safe travel, ensuring vehicle readiness, and arranging parking where necessary.

Travel & Medical Information

All delegates must have valid travel insurance that covers:

- Emergency medical care
- Hospitalisation
- Repatriation if required

Medical services in South Africa are generally of a high standard; however, they can be costly for visitors without adequate insurance. Mothers' Union will not be responsible for any medical expenses or related costs.

Delegates are fully responsible for:

- Carrying all personal medication needed for the duration of the trip
- Ensuring medication is legally permitted to be carried into South Africa
- Managing and paying for any medical treatment required during their stay

There will be a first aid team on site for the duration of the conference; however, their support is limited to immediate, non-clinical care. Please note that first aiders are not permitted to dispense any medication.

Vaccination & Entry Requirements

Please ensure that you have checked your country's requirements and that you are fully vaccinated in accordance with South Africa's travel regulations.

The South African border authorities reserve the right to refuse entry to anyone who does not comply with their travel and health requirements.



Local Hospitals in Durban

Durban has several reputable hospitals, both private and public. Please ensure that your health insurance provides adequate cover for treatment at these facilities. For your convenience, below is a selection of centrally located hospitals for emergency reference:

Accessibility & Mobility

- Durban's main airport and cruise terminals provide wheelchair access, elevators, and mobility-friendly infrastructure.
- Attendees who require mobility aids, medical devices, or special assistance are kindly asked to arrange these independently prior to travel.
- When booking your conference ticket, please advise us of any accessibility requirements so that we can provide appropriate support during the event.

Getting around Durban

Durban is an easy city to navigate. Like any city we recommend you stay safe – don't travel alone at night and it may be simpler to take transport than walk. If you are walking, please make sure you are in a pair or group and that you know where you are going!

Buses: Affordable and useful for major routes; includes the tourist friendly Durban People Mover.

Minibus Taxis: Widely used but require some local know-how for routes and hand signals.

RideHailing (Uber/Bolt/InDriver): Easily available; safer when booked through the app. We recommend you download the app before travel and then it will be easy to use as soon as you arrive in Durban.

Metered Taxis: Reliable but must be phoned – hotel reception desks can arrange them.

Car Rental: Good roads and easy navigation if you have GPS.

Airport Transport: Airport bus or car rental from King Shaka International Airport.

Transport to the event

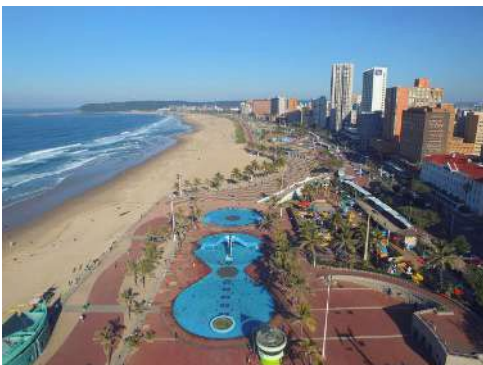
uShaka Marine World

The oldest surviving botanic garden in Africa, known for its orchid house, rare cycads, and tranquil landscapes ideal for leisurely strolls.



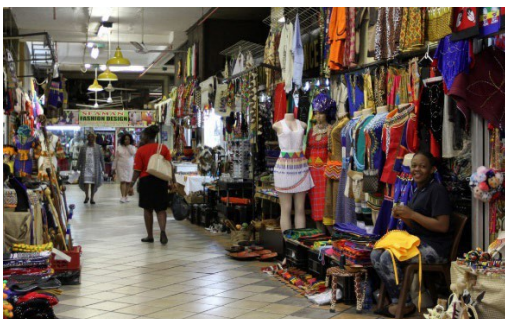
Moses Mabhida Stadium
