Church Based Membership

- In addition to individual membership coalescing as a diocesan branch or group, Mothers' Union (MU) is launching a new membership subscription for Churches where there is currently no relationship with MU or where an MU branch or group has recently closed.

It will:

- Help support the Church's ministry with MU support through resources, worship and training materials and provides access to community work.
- Showcase MU work, volunteering, campaigning and global fundraising opportunities.
- Links Churches to MU local dioceses for additional support whilst enabling members of the congregation to be involved in local MU community projects.
- Lays the foundation for new MU groups to be formed.



Annual Support Package

Throughout the year:

- Copies of MU's Connected Magazine and Prayer Diary
- Selection of leaflets, including Baptism, Family Life, Christianity and Charity (children), Bereavement, Mental Health and Loneliness
- Selection of Worship resources and Services
- Free access to a schedule of MU Webinars on issues affecting family life, and Training Materials, including Metamorphosis Bitesize (Metamorphosis, a bible study led resource that equips people with the inspiration, confidence and skills to work for transformation in their local churches and communities)
- An annual MU Speaker to address the Church on MU work locally and globally
- Links with MU local dioceses and chaplains
- Opportunities to get involved in MU National Programmes and local community projects



How it works!

MU asks for a minimum annual contribution of £150 from participating churches which could be provided directly or generated through dedicating the collection from one service per year to supporting MU social action around the corner and around the world!

MU Church Engagement Ambassadors will be in touch with Churches in their area about this new opportunity.

If a Church is interested, the local diocese will inform the central charity who will action the membership, collect the contribution and will start to release the resources in a phased approach during the year.

The local diocese will manage the relationship and support the Church directly.
